# Establish Safety and Health as a Core Value


Emphasize that you will work together to find and fix workplace hazards so everyone can go home safely.





## Implement a Reporting System


Provide a way for workers to report safety concerns anonymously and without fear of retaliation.



## Provide Training

Train workers on how to identify and control hazards and report incidents.



# Implement Hazard Controls


Make sure workers are involved in selecting, implementing, and evaluating hazard control solutions.


